CANCELLATION POLICY (APPLIES TO ALL SERVICES)

If you fail to attend a booked appointment and have not cancelled it any other appointments you have booked will be automatically cancelled. You will be required to PAY for the missed appointment at the full rate UNLESS you have given AT LEAST 24 HOURS NOTICE of cancellation AND the appointment has been able to be rebooked to another patient. If the appointment is not able to be rebooked you will be asked to pay for it. We endeavour to rebook times but we need sufficient notice to do this as many patients travel to appointments, and others have to organize child care.

FEES & APPOINTMENTS

BULK BILLING to Medicare is available for all children, adolescents, persons with Health Care Cards, unemployed persons, persons with chronic mental health difficulties, pensioners, or other demonstrable hardship. Please note that the only items which can be bulk billed are those approved Medicare Mental Health items.

Standard fees (not bulk billed) will be charged at approximately the Schedule fee as recommended by Medicare for Medicare items eg \$150.00. Medicare refund is \$126.50 for eligible services.

The Private Fee is \$200 if you have no referral. Payment is required at the time of consultation by cash or cheque. I do not have EFT or credit card facilities.

For services to be refunded by Medicare or for bulk billing you need a Mental Health Care Plan from your General Practitioner or specialist (Psychiatrist or Paediatrician). I DO NOT PROVIDE SERVICES ON TEAM CARE OR ENHANCED PRIMARY CARE PLANS. YOU NEED A SEPARATE MENTAL HEALTH CARE PLAN FOR MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES.
